TICKS: It is that nasty time of year again-tick season! We see how bad the ticks are because almost every dog we get into rescue has Lyme's and/or Anaplasma. Use preventative on your dogs and when you do your heart worm test, bump it up to a 4 dx to catch any tick diseases. If your dog has a tick disease, it can cause kidney damage which can lead to death if untreated. Watch for lameness, lethargy, loss of appetite, but sometimes there are no symptoms at all. A few days of lameness which goes away could very well be the disease. The vaccine is not 100% fool proof, so don't get too complacent regarding that. If you need to know if the positive test is from a previous episode, or from the Lyme's vaccine, you can get a C-6 antigen test done to make sure. Treatment is very inexpensive.
